With twenty years in the arts community, she was responsible for many of Seattle's largest arts and music events before transitioning into the corporate world, where she managed a multi-million dollar sponsorship budget and led ground-breaking programs for a former Fortune 100 bank.

Jane formed JZworks in the fall of 2009. A refugee of the financial services sector meltdown, she identified the need for a community leader whose experience is deeply rooted in both the public and private sectors. She channeled her 25 + years of experience into JZworks, and now utilizes her extensive background executing strategies for a wide array of local and national clients.

Career Highlights:
